

THE SERVICE COORDINATION PROJECT FOR HOMELESS PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV/AIDS

It is with enthusiasm that LOFT Community Services, McEwan Housing and Support Services announces that the "***Service Coordination Project for Homeless People Living with HIV/AIDS (PHAs) Who Face Health and Mental Health Crisis***" is now accepting referrals.

'***The Service Coordination Project***' has two main objectives:

1) To increase access to and the continuity of health and community services for People Living with HIV/AIDS who are homeless and experiencing health and/or mental health crises.

2) To increase coordination and integration of services among HIV/AIDS based community agencies, and services from the health, shelter and housing services, and the mental health sectors.

Criteria for Intake/Referral:

- People Living with **HIV/AIDS**,
- Who are **Homeless** or at risk of being homeless.
- Facing a **Health Crisis**,
- And/or a **Mental Health**, or **Substance Use** crisis.

Services Provided:

- Coordinated referral/intake model among formal and informal partner agencies.
- Short Term Intensive Case Management.
- Dedicated beds for acute health care stays.
- Dedicated bed for respite stays.
- Community Nursing Case Management.
- Dedicated housing units.
- Mental Health Support.
- Psychiatric Assessment and Consultation.
- Crisis Intervention.
- Primary Health Care and Community Support(s). Reconnection.
- Substance Use Support.
